



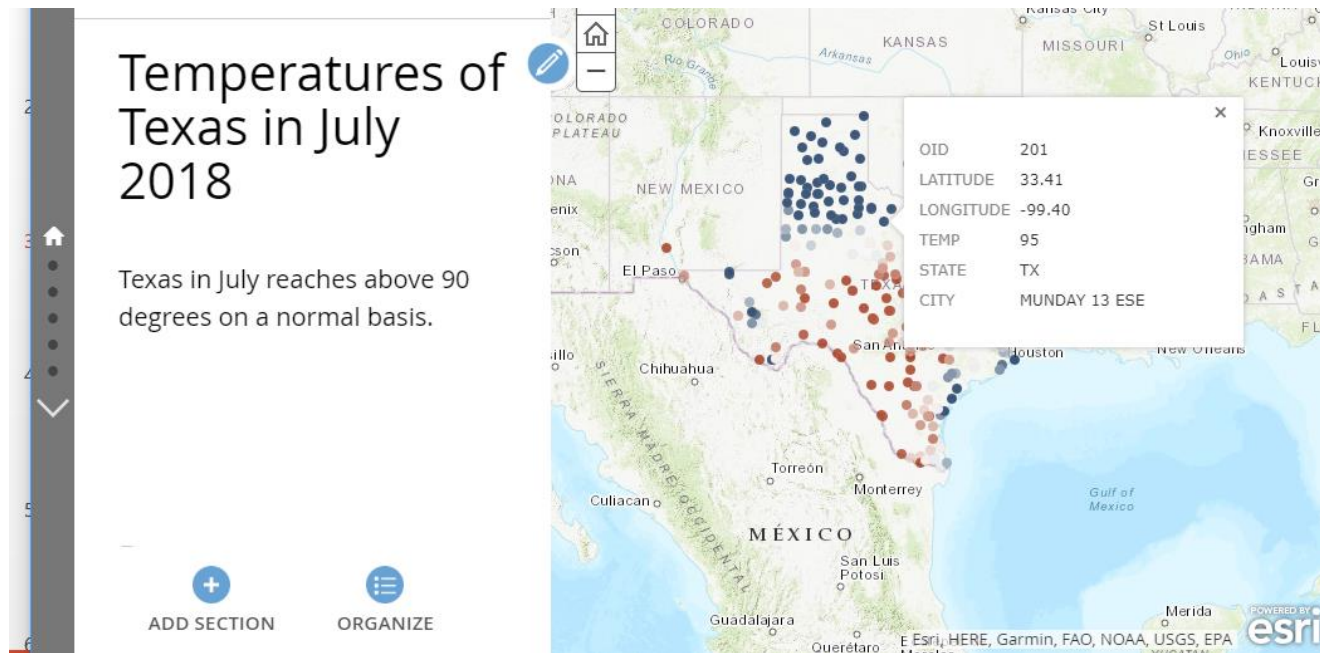

- ▶ Hot spot analysis of temperatures in Texas in July

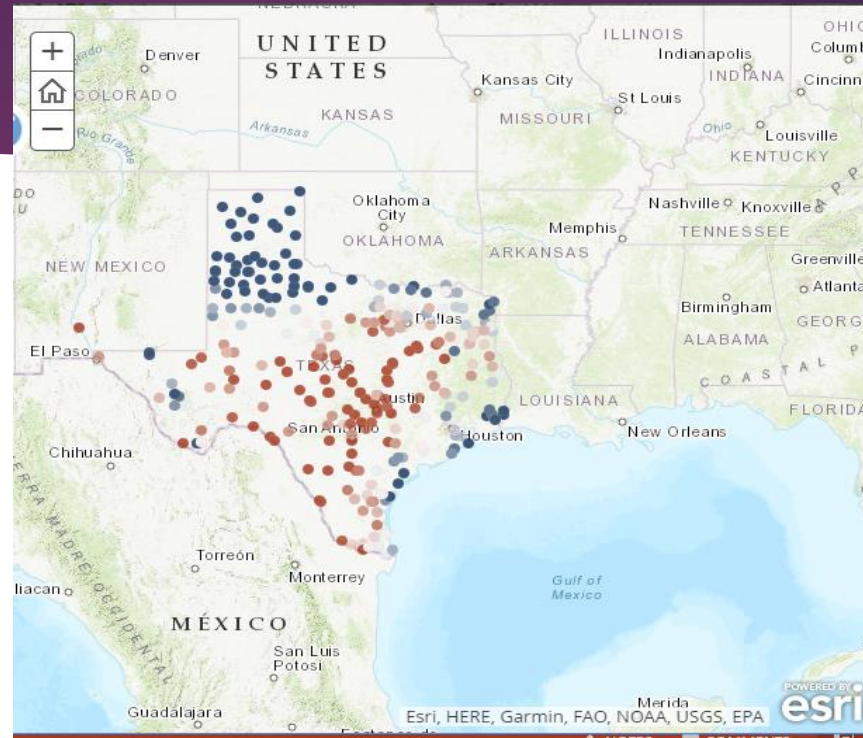
Location or Locations

- Texas and 258 cities in it



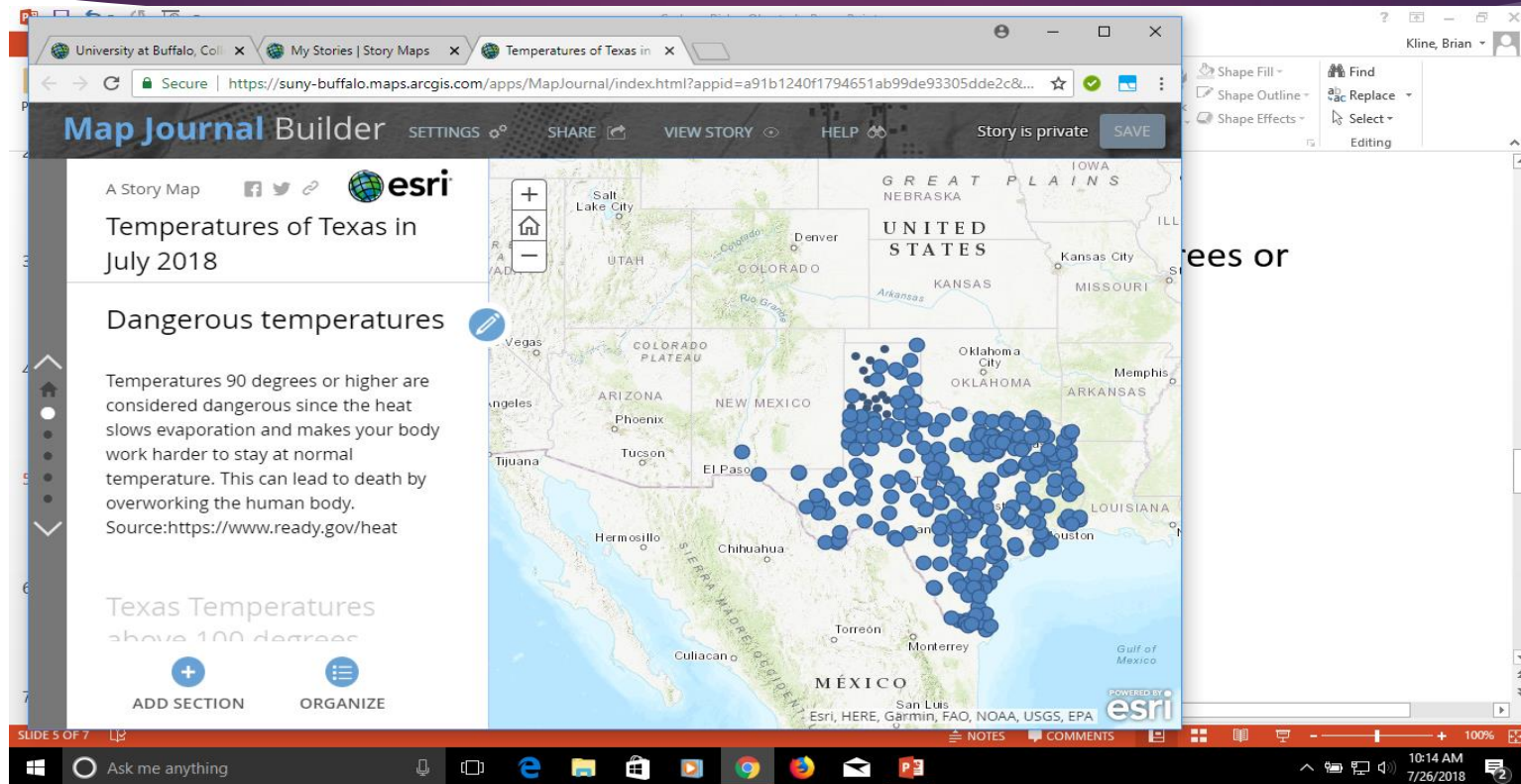
Analysis
