

Moose in Calgary

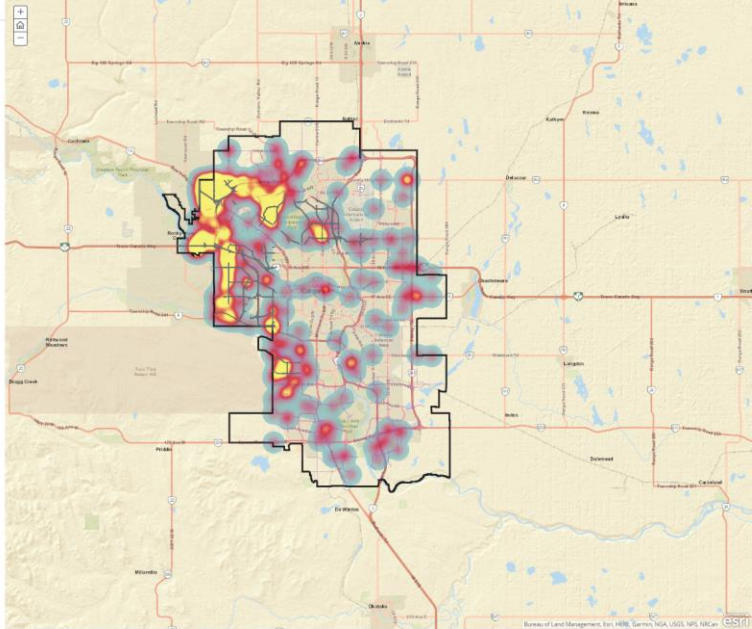
There have been a lot of Moose sightings in Calgary, CA. Many of these have been near major roads and highways.

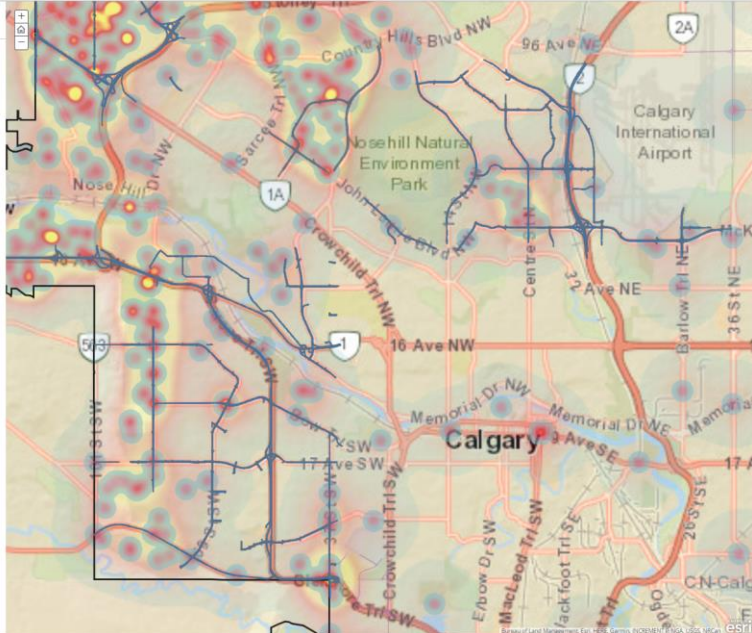


Barriers

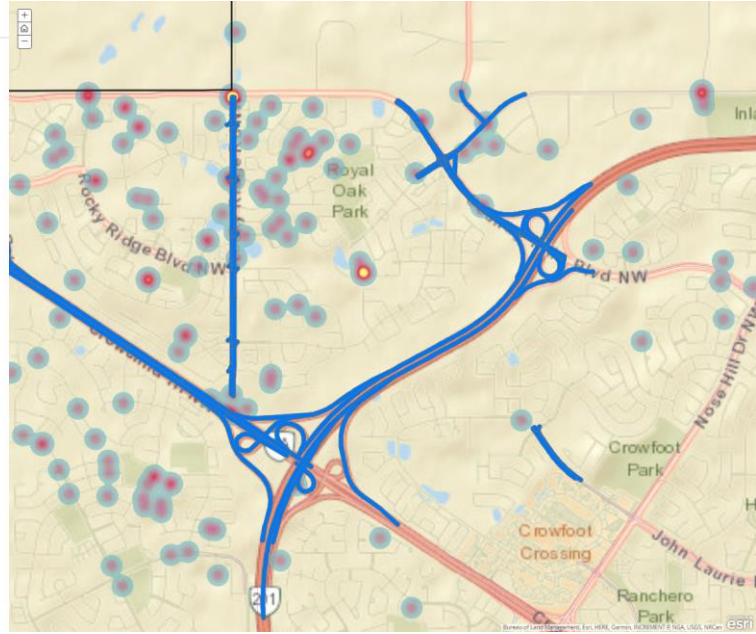
